Youthful fruity citrus flavours, fresh with hints of herbs on the finish, un-oaked. Dry & full.	
<i>Gewurztraminer, Reserva, Alto Los Romeros, Chile 2015, South America</i>	22.95
A classic Alsatian variety gets reworked in Chile – the warmer climes offered by the South American country's Central Valley gives this wine a fresh finesse that's both vibrant and fruity.	
<i>Moselland Riesling Kabinett 2016, Germany</i>	23.95
Benchmark that sings with pure apple fruit & floral tones. Peachy palate, off-dry in style & super refreshing acidity.	
<i>La Petite Vigne Viogner, IGP Pays Doc 2016</i>	23.95
Aromatic & fresh wine with lovely peach & apple blossom character & good peachy fruit on the palate.	
<i>Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico DOC, Pontemagno 2016</i>	24.95
A refreshing dry white, that is crisp with richness & character. Dry & crisp.	
<i>Gavi DOCG, del comune di Gavi</i>	24.95
This small estate's low yields gives this wine a juicy, honey like core. Add the cortese grapes apple like freshness, and you have a standard bearer for Gavi, Piedmonts most famous white.	
<i>Lolo Albariño Rías Baixas, Spain</i>	25.95
Notes of zippy, green apple and lemon peel with a hint of white-fleshed plum.	
<i>Kumeu River Pinot Gris, Auckland, 2014 New Zealand</i>	25.95
Rich & complex, this has a lovely floral quality & a luscious weight on the dry finish.	
<i>Sauvignon Blanc, Tumil Flat, Marlborough 2015, New Zealand</i>	25.95
Classic Kiwi Sauvignon, fresh, crisp, full of gooseberry and nettle fruit with great poise and elegance.	
<i>Gruner Veltliner Weinviertel, Baumgartner 2016</i>	26.95
Terrific dry white with zippy grapefruit character with hints of spice. Dry & crisp.	
<i>Vouvray, Château Gaudrelle 2014, France Loire Valley</i>	27.95
Off-dry Classic Vouvray in the "sec-tendre" style with just the right amount of residual sugar to balance out the racy acidity of the Chenin Blanc grape.	
<i>Chablis 'Le Classique' Pascal Bouchard 2015, France</i>	29.95
Classic Chablis with freshness, minerality & good weight from an excellent producer.	
<i>Pouilly-Fumé, Domaine Jean-Claude Chatelain, France</i>	29.95
Sauvignon Blanc in full glory with a flinty aroma opening into a determined gooseberry crunchiness. Arguably the finest dry, white from the Loire region.

<i>770 Miles Red Zinfandel, California 2016</i>	24.95
Brimming with rich, ripe raspberry, strawberry & blackberry fruit flavours. A no excuses fruit bomb.	
<i>House of Certain Views Shiraz, Hunter Valley</i>	25.95
Black berry fruit meets smoky bacon and wait for those soft, silky tannins to kick in. The perfect accompaniment to any red meat.	
<i>Rioja Vega Crianza 2014, Spain</i>	25.95
Smooth, soft, richly-fruited with spice & vanilla from 12 months in oak. Medium-bodied	
<i>Red Knot Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Australia</i>	28.95
Ripe strawberry and blackberry are embellished with floral, milk chocolate and black pepper nuances.	
<i>Malbec Gouguenheim, Mendoza 2014, Argentina</i>	29.95
A rich dark wine, with red and black fruit character on the nose and palate, a delicious creamy vanilla spice character and a lovely lifted finish.	
<i>Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Telegramme, 2014 France</i>	39.95
Lovely soft fruits with spice, plums, herbs & a touch of leather behind.	
<i>Château Pipeau, Grand Cru Saint-Emilion, France Bordeaux 2011</i>	45.00
Pipeau is a property that has attracted considerably favourable coverage for its recently powerful wines. There is a large amount of new oak used but this supports and complements the concentrated fruit.	
<i>Amarone della Valpolicella, Zeni 2011, Italy</i>	49.00
Amarone is a powerful, concentrated dry red that is properly made from grapes that have been dried in airy barns.	
<i>Cloudy Bay Pinot Noir, New Zealand</i>	60.00
From the famous Cloudy Bay estate come this complex, elegant cherry, cranberry & bramble fruit flavoured Pinot. Layered with spice, tobacco & savoury notes, this is fresh & bright.	
<i>Barolo DOCG, Riva del Bric, Paolo Conterno 2010 Italy</i>	65.00
A fantastic Barolo that has masses of liquorice and black plum flavours and smoothness from having spent 24 hours in French oak barrels.	
<i>Gevrey-Chamertin, Drouhin-Laroze 2013, France</i>	65.00
Drouhin-Laroze has one of the best vineyard holdings of any Gevrey estate to make this impressively balanced & complex wine. It has plenty of fruit & good spiciness on the finish.
